BEFORE TRAVELING TO UAE

- Create a professional strong Resume and Cover letter. Use ResumeCampus.com services.
- 2. Create a LinkedIn Profile, Optimize it. > ResumeCampus.com can help.
- 3. Research your industry and add relevant connections working in that industry in UAE.
- 4. Add all possible recruiters from UAE and approach them via linkedin and email them. Tell them your expected date of arrival in UAE.
